Hi everyone. Today's word of the day is **susceptible**. **Susceptible** means to be impressionable, easily hurt or affected. To be open to something and it's very similar to the word vulnerable that we discussed earlier on this program. **Susceptible** is usually used with the preposition "to".

"So, to be susceptible to something dangerous. To be susceptible to the negative affects ."

Usually it's describing something negative and that is easily occurring or that can happen to someone. And I can use it in this way,

"He had a frail body and weak immune system which made him susceptible to catching colds."

So this is very similar to the word vulnerable. So in this case it means that he is open to receiving colds in that sense. So it made him **susceptible** to catching colds.
